

## STATE OF EMERGENCY IN THE REPUBLIC OF KAZAKHSTAN

On March 15, the President of the Republic of Kazakhstan Kassym-Zhomart Tokayev signed a decree introducing an emergency state in the country in connection with the spread of a new type of coronavirus (Covid-19). The state of emergency will be valid throughout the republic from 08:00 a.m. on March 16, 2020 to 07:00 a.m. on April 15, 2020.

### ALMATY

Since March 19, a quarantine regime was introduced in the territory of Almaty. Entry is prohibited - people are leaving Almaty to prevent the spread of the coronavirus infection COVID-19 into other regions of the Republic of Kazakhstan. From March 28, additional measures were introduced, including, the work of all organizations and enterprises is temporarily suspended in Almaty from March 30 to April 13th, 2020 . The company, whose activity is necessary for the life support of the city will continue its work.

If the company is not allowed to work, but the company believes that its activity is important for the population and life support of the city and wants to continue its activity, it is necessary to fill out the two forms below:

Completed forms are to be sent no later than 6:00 p.m. on March 31, 2020.

It was recommended by the Operational Headquarters to ensure the state of emergency under the Akimat of Almaty city No. 6 dated March 27, 2020 that the working day should be reduced as much as possible and employees should not be allowed to work into the premises without personal protective equipment. Also, employees of companies that continue to work with them must have the appropriate certificates from their place of work. ### NUR-SULTAN

Since March 19, quarantine has been introduced in the city. Since March 28, the quarantine regime has been strengthened, beginning from 00:00 am of March 30 to 00:00 am of April 6, 2020. The activities of all organizations (regardless of ownership) were suspended, with the exception of organizations carrying out their activities indicated below:

1. Health system, including:

- Medical facilities (hospitals, clinics);
- Laboratory services;
- Pharmacies.

2. Veterinary services

3. Urban infrastructure and utilities, including:

- Electricity companies;
- Water supply / heat supply;
- Fire and rescue services;
- Services in the field of housing management (electricians, plumbers, cleaning of yards and premises, emergency services, including elevator maintenance);
- Street and room cleaning;
- Collection, processing and disposal of garbage and waste;
- disinfection;
- Organizations providing the functioning of technical means of traffic regulation;
- Telecommunications and communications;
- Services of specialized vehicles and taxi services;
- Postal, courier services.

4. The airport.

5. Distribution networks, supermarkets and grocery stores related to food and basic necessities, including stores located in multi-apartment residential buildings.

6. The media.

7. Gasoline stations and gas stations.

8. Other important services, including:

- services for the delivery of food, pharmaceuticals and medical products, as well as essential goods.
- restaurants, cafes only with the acceptance of online orders and food delivery by couriers with enhanced compliance with sanitary standards until 20:00.
- trade and logistics centers, warehouses, distribution of food, pharmaceuticals and medical products.

9. State bodies (central and other) and their subordinate organizations that ensure the smooth functioning of public administration by decision of the first leaders.

If the scope of the organization's activities is not listed above, but the head of this organization believes that the organization's activities are important for the population and life support of the city or cannot be stopped due to the specifics of the activity, it is necessary to provide a written request with a



justification, having previously contacted by number 109 to be redirected to the Operational Headquarters preventing the spread of coronavirus infection in Nur Sultan city.

All organizations and enterprises from industries that are not included in the list of permitted activities should suspend normal business hours and can continue to operate remotely, including online.

Additional restrictions in connection with the emergency state are also imposed in the cities of Karaganda, Abai, Saran, Temirtau, Shakhtinsk, Atyrau, Kyzylorda in the West Kazakhstan, Mangistau, Kostanay, Akmola and Zhambyl regions.
