

Renewable energy pass-through tariff introduced in Kazakhstan



On December 7, 2020 President signed the Law



On Amendments and Additions to Certain Legislative Acts of the Republic of Kazakhstan on Supporting the Use of Renewable Energy Sources and Electricity



The purpose of the amendments

is to reduce the losses of conventional energy producing organisations that buy electricity, produced by RES facilities.

In order to prevent losses

the costs of purchasing electricity produced by RES facilities from FSC will be included in the surcharge in excess of the maximum tariff of the conventional energy producing organisation.

In accordance with the new edition of the RES Law

the **pass-through tariff** for the support of RES is defined as a surcharge to support the RES which is the price determined by the FSC in accordance with the zone of electricity consumption for energy producing organisations that are conditional or qualified conditional consumers.

The RE pass-through tariff applies from July 1, 2021.
